Harborough Mail Sports Awards

Harborough Sport and Activity Alliance sponsored an award at the ceremony for the first time. The special award recognising achievement and contribution to sport in the district was awarded to

Terry Waterfield from Lutterworth Juniors and Youth FC. The nomination below shows how much Terry has done for sport in Lutterworth.

TERRY Waterfield has been nominated for one of the awards by Lutterworth Juniors and Youth FC committee, friends and by the hundreds of children that have played and represented the club over the last 23 years.

Terry, of Waterworks Lane, Lutterworth, is a founder member of the LJ and YFC and has remained a stalwart of the club.

He is also a founder member of Lutterworth Athletic FC which was launched in 1993 and sees the junior and youth members go into senior soccer.

He managed the team that took his son right through the club and is now assisting him to run the Under-15s squad from soccer school (Under-7), in order to see his grandson do the same.

Terry is also chairman of the District League at Holmes Park.

He was nominated for the Sports Personality title by Haydn Watkins of Cunningham Drive, Lutterworth, who said: "This year Terry retires as vice chairman of Lutterworth J and YFC and as chairman of Lutterworth Athletic FC and must surely be recognised as one of Lutterworth's unsung heroes.

"He has remained a stalwart of these clubs and his commitment to the youngsters of the area over the last 23 years is a fantastic achievement.

"We admire and respect him and thank him for his love and dedication to these clubs which provide scores of children and youth with the opportunity to play local league football and, of course, have fun.

"Terry is truly an inspiration to us all and hundreds of local kids salute him."
